

Missing Transaction Code: Error 00042001

This error occurs when the required Transaction Code is missing from the Link Data record. Because the Transaction Code determines how the transaction is processed, the transaction is rejected before it can be loaded into Policy Data Manager.



Find

the rejected transaction identified in the PCRB reject notification email.



Verify

that the Transaction Code field is populated on the Link Data record.



Confirm

the Transaction Code matches the type of policy transaction being reported.



Update

the Transaction Code in your source system, regenerate the transaction, and resubmit it.

Tip: Because Transaction Code is Link Data, it must be reported consistently across all records in a transaction. Missing or inconsistent Link Data prevents the transaction from loading into Policy Data Manager.

Why It Happens

The Transaction Code identifies the type of policy transaction being submitted to the DCO and determines how the transaction is interpreted and processed. This occurs when the Transaction Code is missing:

- ✓ the transaction cannot be associated with its related records
- ✓ the transaction is rejected
- ✓ the transaction is not loaded into Policy Data Manager

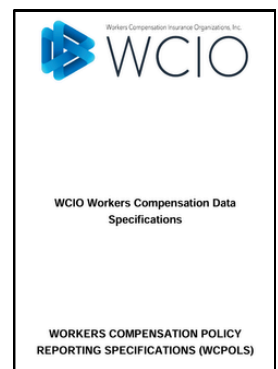
